Shuttles will run approximately every 20 minutes throughout the hours of operation.

ARRIVAL

- **PARK** at Northern Arizona University (NAU), within Parking Lots P62, P64 & P66 for the free off-site parking and shuttle service.
- NAU Parking Entrance DIRECTIONS:
 - Proceed to S. San Francisco St & Pine Knoll Drive on the Northern Arizona University (NAU); Campus Parking Lots P62, P64 or P66
 - Shuttle Lot P66 Address for GPS: 1701 S San Francisco St Flagstaff, AZ 86011
 - Shuttle Lot P64 Address for GPS: 2551 E Pine Knoll Dr Flagstaff, AZ 86011
 - Shuttle Lot P62 Address for GPS: 175 E Pine Knoll Dr, Flagstaff, AZ 86001
- Utilize the free shuttle service to and from Fort Tuthill (map below). DO **NOT** drive to Fort Tuthill (On-Site parking is **SOLD OUT** you will be redirected to NAU to park and use the free shuttles).
- After parking at NAU, walk to the check in / shuttle stop within the lot to have your ticket scanned. Tickets must be signed before boarding shuttle.
- Your QR code is your ticket! Please have your QR code (print / digital) ready to ensure a smooth check-in process upon arrival.
- Please REVIEW and SIGN the general liability waiver located in your ticket confirmation email; this is required before your arrival onsite.

- Additional Day / Weekend Pass tickets may be purchased at the check-in / shuttle stop as well.
- Take the shuttle to Overland Expo (note: refer above to exact shuttle times)
- After drop off, walk to the main entrance where you will receive show materials, such as our Overland Newsletter, an event map, and daily schedules.

REMINDERS

- If ADA parking accommodations have been requested, please present your ADA placard. Please bring along any personal wheelchairs or assisted devices, as needed.
- Potable water will be available to fill water bottles only.
- No camping or Overnight Parking in NAU Parking Lots.
- No grilling or open flames in NAU Parking Lots.
- No glass containers on the shuttles.
- No smoking (this includes e-cigarettes and vapes) on the shuttles.
- Well-behaved and leashed dogs are welcome on the shuttles and at Overland Expo.
- Shuttles will have bicycle mounts for transport, however, no one may ride bikes within the vendor row. They must be parked/locked along the bike fence next to the main entrance.

PLAN AHEAD

- Download the <u>Overland Expo App</u> Powered by Timberline Heating. Choose the 2023 WEST Event. Log in with your unique email used within your ticket registration. The app will provide a venue map that will guide you to exhibitors, food vendors, and the general class schedule. Create your account PRIOR to arriving at the event.
